TruMACC is a college transition partnership between Truman State University and Moberly Area Community College to give you access to both institutions' resources and better help you transition to Truman when you're ready to do so.

You'll enroll at MACC (9-12 credit hours) to qualify for financial aid and use your A+ program benefits if you have any. You'll also pay the out-of-district tuition rate at MACC for your Truman courses (3-6 credit hours), which is currently \$181/credit for the 22-23 academic year plus applicable fees.

You can choose to live on-campus at Truman, and may qualify for a housing scholarship based on need. Housing scholarships are currently awarded to students with an EFC of \$12,000 or less through FAFSA.

You are able to take advantage of professional advising support, most student organizations, and facilities on both campuses while co-enrolled.

You can choose when you want to apply to transfer to Truman full time. Those who complete their associate of arts or sciences degree receive automatic admission to Truman and TruPlus scholarships covering half of their Truman tuition.
